# WHAT IF...

- You could be running Zabbix 3.2 without issues for a long time
- But what if suddenly you hit a known bug?
  - Your version is not supported anymore
  - You still must upgrade
  - No time for preparation
  - No time for tests




# LTS OR STANDARD

- But what if you desperately need new functionality?



#### IT IS NOT EASY TO KEEP UP!

- What version you are running in production?
- Why not latest? Reasons for that usually are very similar.
  - We have a lot of customization and afraid that it will stop working
  - We want to avoid downtime of our Monitoring system
  - Hard to get accept from management
  - Current version has proved that it's stable



#### IT IS NOT EASY TO KEEP UP!

- You have many customizations?
  - A lot of new things are covered with native functionality in new releases
  - Things are changing and some of your customizations might not be needed anymore
- Need examples?
  - Low Level Discovery was added only in Zabbix 2.0. What users did before that?
  - Pre-processing was introduced in Zabbix 3.4. A lot of scripts were deleted then.
  - Native webhook support. You don't need complicated alertscripts anymore.



# **DOWNTIME IS NOT AN OPTION?**

- There always are ways how to perform upgrade with minimal downtime.
  - Clone your existing instance
  - Move all the traffic to clone
  - Upgrade production
  - Move traffic back to production
  - Merge history from clone to prod

# IS IT EASY TO UPGRADE?

- Upgrade directly to your desired version
- Agents are backwards compatible
- What about Zabbix proxy?
- Most Important Upgrade notes

- Server OS support lifecycle
- Software lifecycle
- Security concerns
- Vulnerability
- Employee qualification
